

Santa Clara, Utah, History Museum with Samuel Knight Exhibit



The Samuel Knight Santa Clara History Museum is now open to the public (and of great interest to Knight descendants), Saturday and Tuesday from 11 AM to 4 PM. The museum is located in the basement of the Santa Clara Town Hall, Santa Clara, Utah.

The museum displays artifacts, photos, memorabilia and depictions of early Knight ancestors to the Dixie area. The project was spearheaded and funded by Charlie Clayton to honor his Knight ancestors Josephine Barbara Baumann Knight and Samuel Knight.

He also donated a \$1500 bronze plaque at the Santa Clara Heritage Square to her name, among other plaques to the Cotton Mission Chapter.
